BYLAW NO. 2016 - 03

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494 for the Purpose of Establishing a 60 km/hour Speed Limit for Certain Vehicles Upon Municipal Roads within the Municipality.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Speed Bylaw."

2. In this bylaw:

- (a) "municipal road" means a road used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and does not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to the provisions of The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997;
- (b) "speed zone" means any portion of a municipal road within the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494 as designated herein and identified by a sign erected and maintained at each end thereof indicating the maximum speed applicable thereto.
- That a maximum speed of sixty (60) kilometers per hour be established for trucks over eight (8) tonnes for all municipal roads within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494.
- 4. Any person found guilty of the violation of the speed set out in Section 3 of this Bylaw shall, upon summary conviction, be subject to the penalties set out in *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* and the regulations thereto as they relate to those travelling within a speed zone at a greater speed than which is permitted.
