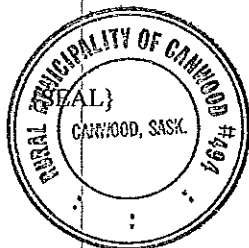



BYLAW NO. 2017 - 12


A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494 to regulate and control the Dumping of Waste on property under the ownership or control of the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494 pursuant to Section 8(2)(e) of The Municipalities Act.

The Council of the RM of Canwood No. 494, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Anti-Dumping Bylaw.
2. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494.
 - b. "Waste" means any of the following:
 - discarded or abandoned organic or inorganic material, including material or by-products discarded in a manufacturing or producing process;
 - dirt, rocks, or rubble;
 - garbage;
 - trees or tree cuttings;
 - grass or leaves;
 - empty or partly empty tins, boxes, cartons, bottles and containers;
 - discarded paper, fabrics and household utensils;
 - household furniture and appliances of any nature;
 - concrete;
 - any other refuse, rubble, or matter.
 - c. "Dumping" means abandoning Waste or causing Waste to be abandoned in any location other than in a receptacle provided for the collection of Waste, as approved under the authority of *The Litter Control Act*.
3. Pursuant to Section 3(1) of *The Litter Control Act*, Dumping Waste within the Municipality is prohibited, and any person found guilty of this offence shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided pursuant to Section 4 of *The Litter Control Act*.
4. In addition to any penalty assessed, a person convicted of an offence pursuant to this bylaw shall also be responsible for the cost incurred by the Municipality for Waste disposal and clean-up at an hourly rate and:
 - a. The charge shall not be less than a three and one half (3.5) hour minimum.
 - b. The hourly rate shall be calculated as the sum of the following:
 - i. Labour cost minimum for two employees at the current rate for operators.
 - ii. Equipment cost at the current Custom Work Rates of the municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 2014-12 is hereby repealed.
6. This bylaw shall come into force immediately.
