

ARE YOU WILLING TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SOMEONE ELSE'S LIFE?

The destruction of R.M. signs, roads and property is considered mischief, and the removal or theft of signs constitutes theft under \$5,000.00. Both are **CRIMINAL CHARGES**.

We are asking for the PUBLIC's assistance to report known incidences of such matters to police at **306-747-2606** in Shellbrook, **306-469-2590** in Big River, **306-883-4210** in Spiritwood or Crime Stoppers at **1-800-222-TIPS (8477)**. If the matter is time sensitive or requires immediate attention, please call **911**. Incidents can also be posted to the Parkland Rural Crime Watch providing the witness is a member.

Traffic signs are used to alert drivers. Signs such as **STOP, YIELD, DEAD END, CURVE or ROAD CLOSED** help drivers prepare for what is ahead. They are a tool to make our roadways safer. When these signs are stolen or destroyed, drivers have no notification of what is ahead, making drivers a danger to themselves as well as others on the roadways.

The maintenance of roads and signs is very costly to R.M. property owners. BUT more importantly the R.M. signs are used by emergency personnel (**Fire, First Responders, Ambulances and Police**) to get to people who are in emergent need of medical or safety assistance. The absence of these signs increases the arrival time of emergency personnel and could mean **LIFE OR DEATH**.
