

ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE

Election for Division 1 Councillor

Voting in Divisions

Each voter is entitled to vote for **ONE** division councillor.

Residency is a qualification requirement that impacts voters. For the purpose of a municipal election, a person's **RESIDENCE** is the place that he or she typically refers to as "home."

The **DIVISION** where a person is eligible to vote is determined **FIRST** by where the voter **RESIDES**.

- If you **RESIDE** in **Division 1**, you are eligible to vote.
- If you reside in a different division, you **ARE NOT** eligible to vote.
- If you **RESIDE outside of the R.M. of Canwood No. 494 AND** own assessed property in **Division 1** (*or are the spouse of that person*), you are eligible to vote.
